Dear KLJ member,
Dear parent/guardian of the KLJ member,

KLJ wants to be accessible to everyone, which is why you can make use of the KLJ support fund. If, for whatever reason, you need to do so, you only pay 20% of the national portion of the membership fee. The rest of the cost is covered by the local KLJ department of which your child is affiliated as a member and KLJ National.

The support fund is available for anyone who needs it, without any stigma.

The support fund is based on a genuine need for solidarity. If you want to apply for the support fund, you do not have to prove why you need the support. As the board and management team of the local KLJ department, we do not know who is applying for support. KLJ National only informs us that the support fund has been used, but not by whom.

To guarantee this anonymity, it is not possible for anyone from the board to apply for the support fund on behalf of one of the members. The person who wishes to make use of the support fund can only submit the application themselves.

Please note that you cannot use the support fund if you receive a discount thanks to [UITPAS](#) via the opportunity rate.

How does it work exactly?

If you use the support fund for the membership fee, you will be reimbursed 80% of the registration fee that the local KLJ department owes to KLJ National (€26). 40% of this sum is financed by the local KLJ department and 40% by the KLJ National support fund.

You can apply for support via the form in Twizzit. Be sure to fill in your bank account number in the box provided. This will ensure that the administration runs smoothly and that the amount can be easily reimbursed. Invoicing and reimbursement

For the membership fee support fund, there are four fixed dates in the year on which the secretariat arranges invoicing to departments and reimbursement to members (or their parents):

- January 15,
- March 15,
- July 1,
- August 20.
